Entrance Qualification

You have to satisfy all of the following conditions.

1. Completion of the curriculum of more than 12 years (when you enter to our school)
2. Acquisition of Japanese language proficiency of more than level N5 before application to our school.
3. No criminal record, No misconduct in overseas travel
4. Reliable parents (or financial sponsor) and their financial support

Selection Process

You need to pass the exam below.

1. Written exam (Japanese, English, Math)
2. Interview (including Japanese conversation test)
3. Documents screening (Application materials of Certificate of Eligibility)

★Other Payments…Facility fee, Material fee, Extracurricular activities fee, Insurance fee, Healthcare fee, etc

【Due date for payment】

- (1) You must pay the first year school expense according to the payment invoice we send you (within 2 week after your "CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY " has issued).
- (2) You must pay second year school expense according to the payment invoice we show you (within 1 year after your payment of the first year school expense).

【Payment Method】

You can pay the ways below.

- (1) Bank transfer (Oversea remittance). Please burden bank transfer fee at your expense.
- (2) Cash payment at our school.

【Refund of school expense】

- (1) In case that the visa did not issued although you applied it.

We will refund all the school expense except examination fee.

- (2) Admission decline

In the case that you (or your parents) decline admission to our school by the end of previous month of admission month, we will refund a part of the school expense except examination fee and entrance fee.

- (3) Voluntary leaving school

In case that you get permission of the headmaster and leave school voluntary, we will refund a part of school expense according to remaining learning period.

※ In case of expelling(bad grades,bad attendance rate,crime,etc), the school expense will not be refunded.

Living fee and
other costs

When you start new life in Japan, at first you have to pay initial cost, and then, you have to pay recurring cost as below.

【The main initial cost of starting new life in Japan】

Initial costs of apartment rental agreement(★)	brokerage fee, fire insurance premiums, guarantee fees, etc	50,000～100,000JPY
Consumer electronics(★)	refrigerator, washing machine, microwave oven, rice cooker, etc.	30,000～60,000JPY
Kitchenware, dishes, etc(★)	Pot, frying pan, kitchen knife, dish etc.	3,000～10,000JPY
Bedding(★)	Japanese futon, sheets, pillow, etc	6,000～10,000JPY
Bicycle	bicycle(including bike registry fee)	6,000～10,000JPY
Mobile phone	Communication expenses isn't included.	3,000～8,000JPY
Total of initial costs	If you start new life by yourself, you should prepare 100,000～200,000JPY at least.	98,000～ 270,000JPY

If you start new life in our dormitory, you need not pay the costs marked (★) basically.

【Monthly recurring cost】

Room rent	If you share by roommate, room rent of yours will be get down.	15,000～40,000JPY
Utility cost	Electricity, Gas, Water costs fluctuates according to the season.	2,000～10,000JPY
Food expenses	You can save food expense by cooking yourself.	15,000～30,000JPY
Communication expenses	Mobile phone fee, Internet fee	2,000～10,000JPY
Daily goods expenses	Consumables such as toilet paper, etc	3,000～5,000JPY
Clothing costs	It fluctuates according to the season.	1,000～5,000JPY
Learning related costs	Book fee, stationery fee, etc.	1,000～3,000JPY
National Health Insurance	It fluctuates according to your income.	2,000～3,000JPY
Others	Medical cost, haircut cost, etc	1,000～3,000JPY

**Dormitory
(School-
rented
dormitory)**

Although we don't have our own dormitory, we provide a dormitory that we rent for students.
If you want to use our dormitory, please pay dormitory fee (and school expense)
within 2 week after your "CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY " has issued.

【Dormitory fee／Expense per a person in case that two people share a room】

Initial cost	Contract cost (money paid to the owner, brokerage fee, fire insurance premiums, guarantee fees, etc) and facility fee for starting new life (consumer electronics, bedding, kitchenware, and so on)	50,000JPY
Rents	Amount of 6 months rent. If you want to live a dormitory continuously after 6 months, please prepay dormitory rent every month.	150,000JPY
Security deposit	The purpose of this deposit is repairing and cleaning of the dormitory. So, if you break the facilities or get dirty a dormitory, this deposit will not be returned.	30,000JPY
Total	Dormitory fee for 6 months	230,000JPY

When you hesitate room share, you can occupy a room by paying the dormitory fee for 2 persons (380,000JPY/6 months).

【Dormitory outline】

Dormitory rooms are roughly same but a little different each others.
Dormitory address, room size, furniture and home appliances may be a little different.
Location of dormitory・・・within 15 minutes by bicycle.
Home appliances and equipments

Dormitory room is ordinary one room apartment house of Japan.
Home appliances as below will be provided by our school.
Refrigerator, microwave, rice cooker, washing machine
bedding set, kitchenware, dishes is provided by school too.

Part time jobs

You can do part time job after getting the permission to engage in activity other than that permitted under the status of residence.

【Application procedure】

You can take the procedure in Immigration Bureau counter just after you arrive at airport.
We send you application form in advance, and you can submit it after fill it up.
You can take the procedure of it at a later date, but, in that case,
you need to wait at least a week to get the permission.
So, please take the procedure at the airport as much as possible.

【Important points of part time jobs】

You can do part time job only after getting the permission to engage in activity other than that permitted under the status of residence.
(If you don't have, you cannot do part time job.)
You can do part time job within 28 hours a week (in case of the long vacation,
within 40 hours a week and 8 hours a day), and you cannot do a job such as brothel,
pachinko parlor, and so on.
We will explain about it in detail after you enter our school.

Application Documents and Materials

The required materials will be changed by the Immigration Bureau, and those materials vary with the applicant's educational background or the financial sponsor's occupation and so on.

1.	Application Form	The original form of our school (You can download from HP)
2.	Reasons studying Japanese	The original form of our school (You can download from HP)
3.	Photo (Size 4cm × 3cm) ...4pcs	Photos taken within 3 months.
4.	Copy of passport (or ID card)	You can submit the copy of your ID card only if you don't have the passport.
5.	Diploma or Graduation certificate (last school)	Please submit the original.
6.	Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency more than N5	Please submit the original certificate of the following Japanese language proficiency test. JLPT (N5 and over) 、 J.TEST (F and over, or 250point in E-F level exam) 、 NAT-TEST (5 and over) 、 TOPJ (Primay A and over) 、 J-cert (Sub-intermediate and over) In the case that you have already taken the exam or planned to take the exam (you have not obtained any results yet), please submit the copy of the admission ticket of the exam. In the absence of the above material, you have to submit the Japanese Learning Certificate (learning hours and so on should be shown) issued by the Japanese language school you have studied.
7.	Copy of family register	The copy of public documents proving family members and their relationship.
8.	Statement of Pledge	The original form of our school (You can download from HP)
9.	Credential Report	Only Chinese student have to submit the Credential Report

○Application documents and materials for the financial sponsor (usually, your father or mother)

1.	Statement of paying expenses	The original form of our school (You can download from HP)
2.	Proof of employment or occupation	Documents to prove the occupation or the position at the company of the financial sponsor.
3.	Income proof	Documents to prove the income of last 3 years.
4.	Certificate of tax payment	Documents to prove the tax payment of last 3 years.
5.	Certificate of bank balance	Documents to prove the bank balance of the financial sponsor.
6.	Documents to prove the relationship between the financial sponsor and the	e.g. Birth certificate, Relationship notarization letter, etc...
7.	Copy of family register	The copy of public documents proving the financial sponsor's family members and their relationship.
8.	Documents to prove the process of the saving.	e.g. Deposit / withdrawal statement, the copy of bank passbook of last 3 years

※ The Immigration Bureau sometimes requests materials other than the above according to the nationality or the financial sponsor's residence country (if they live in Japan).
In such a case, please cooperate to submit those materials Immigration Bureau request.

【 Notes on filling in 】

- The applicant(the student) certainly needs to write application documents by himself.
The same can be said for the financial sponsor.
- When you make mistake,please correct it by a double line,and write correct matters in the margin.
- If you don't know how to write, don't write in your own way, please contact us.
- If you don't fill in all necessary information or you fill incorrect information inadvertently,
we can't accept your application.

Off course, in such a case, you can't get a status of residence, and so, please check
your application documents and materials carefully before you submit them.

【 Notes on submitting 】

- Please be sure to submit by the deadline. But, some materials can be submitted after the deadline,
and so, in case of late submission, please be sure to contact us (or your study abroad agency).
- Expiration date of certificate that will be accepted at the Immigration Bureau is within six months.
- When you send documents to Japan, please use EMS(Express Mail Service) or so on
to trace its delivery status.
- Please copy all the documents and materials before submitting.

Because we (or the Immigration Bureau,too)will call you to confirm contents of
the documents and materials you have submitted.
