Entrance qualifications and selection method

【Entrance qualification】

- Educational qualifications above high school graduation (including graduation prospects)
- Japanese proficiency above N5(JLPT)
- Parents whose payment ability is enough agree with your studying abroad

【Selection process】

- Paper test (Japanese, English, Composition, etc)
- Interview (include Japanese conversation)
- Documents screening (necessary for applying for a Certificate of Eligibility)

【Return of tuition】

A part of school expenses will be return in the case below.

(1) In the case of refusal of VISA

If you apply the visa and the embassy refuse your application, the school expenses you paid will return except for application fee.

(2) Admission Decline

If you decline admission by the end of previous month of the month you should enroll, the school expenses you paid will be returned except for application fee and entrance fee.

(3) Voluntary dropout

If you dropped out in the middle of the term through regular procedure, the school expenses you have already paid will be returned according to the unlearned period

※ If you are expelled for your own problem (low attendance rate, failing score, crime and so on), the school expenses you have already paid will not be returned.







We provide you a variety of original scholarship program to support your study.

Prior Study scholarship	20,000～ 60,000 yen	This scholarship will be given according to the level of Japanese you get before entrance(more than N5). And you need to show that you maintain the equal level at the placement test after the enrolment.
JLPT scholarship	10,000～ 30,000 yen	This scholarship will be given in the case of acquiring the Japanese level more than N3 in JLPT during your study in our school.
EJU scholarship	10,000～ 30,000 yen	This scholarship will be given in the case of acquiring excellent score in EJU during your study in our school.
Tuition reduction	10,000～ 60,000 yen	The second period's tuition will be reduced according to the attendance rate and the score in regular examination of first year.

※ In case of cheating in examination, of course, these scholarship will not be provided.
